Advisory Plan for Week 5: Purpose & Motivation				
Wednesday, 9/16	Thursday, 9/17			
Overview: Students will be writing their eulogy in hopes of fleshing out their values, roles, and motivations. This also sets up next week's intrinsic and extrinsic motivation.	Overview: Students ascribe their dreams and hopes expressed in their eulogy onto the Da Vinci Venn diagram (see Student Planner front cover).			
Materials: Lined paper. Pen/ pencils.	Materials: Yesterday's eulogies. Projector and whiteboard markers.			
Procedure: Students write the eulogy for their eventual funeral (15 minutes). Students reflect on questions with their small group. Students share their reflections with the entire advisory.	Procedure: Students read and respond to a John Wooden quote. Ask students what is their main goal: a reputation or character. You might want to explain the difference. Students reread their eulogy and place different roles found in their lives into four categories. Teacher projects the Da Vinci Venn diagram on wall and students write down their roles on the board. As a class, discuss how circles merge and are separate. What are some takeaways from these past two days?
