ADVISORY: EXPLOTEING IDENTITY

BIZOUGHT TO YOU BY FIZANK, MS. MUIZATALLA, MS. KONDO, MIZ WIMETZ, MS. LIANG & MS. HEIZNANDEZ

Teachers will distribute colored stars to the class. Stars will be provided for you in your mailbox. The teacher will read from an easy to follow script guiding students through different LGBT coming-out scenarios.

It should take about 20 minutes to go through the entire process. The idea is that each kid's color symbolizes a different coming-out pathways. The scenarios range from warm and receptive to very painful events that lead to suicide.

This topic deals with sensitive issues and the activity might hit home on a personal note for some students. So be mindful of their dispositions as you go through the activity.

Once you finished reading the script, have a class discussion. Here are some questions you can use:

What was something you learned?

What really spoke to you?

Has there ever been a time when you had to share something with somebody and you were terrified about how they would respond?

The main objective for this is to open the eyes of students to the very real fear that closet LGBT people feel and the consequences of shunning the LGBT community.

The purpose of this lesson is to provide an opportunity to talk to others who share parts of your own identity, and then to hear from others who have an identity that is different from yours.

Combined Advisories: Have students get in groups based on their selfidentified identities. They should discuss the following questions:

- What are your experiences with the advantages and challenges of growing up being what you are?
- 2) What are some times when you found yourself saying, "I'm glad I'm "?
- 3) What are some times when you have said, "It's a challenge to be _____"?

Single Advisory: Run a council with your own advisory following this plan:

- Set up a center with talking pieces and make a circle. <u>Students</u> from the same identity group should sit near each other in the circle.
- 2) Open the council (pick one: one-clap, chime, three breaths)
- Remind everyone about the tenants of council: speak from the heart, listen from the heart, speak leanly, & speak spontaneously.
- 4) The council prompt is as follows: "What group did you identify with, and what's it like for you to be identified with this group? What do you like about it, and what are some of the difficulties?"
- 5) After each identity shares, do a witness round* for that identity. Identities should be seated next to each other in the big circle.
 *A witness round means sharing one word or phrase that echoes what you heard someone say.
- Close the council: pass the stomp or pass the squeeze or pass the handshake
