In order to earn the honors designation for a course at DVS, students will be required to earn a passing score on one midterm exam and one final exam for that course. Please initial on the line next to each of the items below to indicate your understanding of the requirements:

\_\_\_\_ Passing score for midterm or final is a 3 or better on every EKS assessed.

\_\_\_\_ Content on honors midterm and final exams is comprehensive and supplemental. This means that the exams cover all essential skills taught in the class up until the point of the exam, and some additional content not taught within the context of the regular class will also be tested.

\_\_\_\_ In order to be eligible to take the honors final exam, students must earn a 3 or better on each Essential Skill assessed on the midterm <u>and</u> have an overall grade of B- or better in the class at the time of the final exam.

\_\_\_\_ There are no re-takes allowed on midterm or final exams. If a student misses an exam, the student and his/her parent must schedule a meeting with school administration to discuss the situation and determine whether or not a makeup exam is warranted.

\_\_\_\_ Students wishing to take the midterm/final in 4 or more courses must have a meeting with their counselor, after which the counselor will make a recommendation to the parents.

\_\_\_Honors midterms and finals will not be used as evidence of mastery in the overall course grade, but only as qualification for the honors designation.

## Additional Information About Honors Courses

All courses with an honors designation at DVS count as an additional grade point value in the DVS GPA calculation. Private universities recognize all DVS Honors courses.

When calculating a student's UC/CSU GPA to determine if the student meets or exceeds the minimum GPA, the number of designated honors courses receiving the additional grade points is limited to eight semesters. Students may complete more than eight semesters of honors coursework, but a maximum of eight extra points will be factored into the UC/CSU GPA.

All 9th grade courses (English 9, Physics, PLTW - Introduction to Design, Algebra 1, Geometry, Statistics, & Spanish 1) and Algebra 2, and Spanish 2 are <u>not</u> eligible for UC and CSU honors designation and will <u>not</u> count as additional GPA point value in the CSU GPA calculation. However, the UC and CSU systems will recognize that by taking these honors courses, the student has selected a rigorous curriculum. This adds competitive components to a student's college application. These policies are for UC and CSU systems only.

Most students complete UC/CSU designated honors courses in grades 11 and 12, although some may complete these courses as early as grade 10. UC/CSU limits the amount of extra points added to the GPA for designated honors courses completed in grade 10 to no more than four semesters. This limitation also only affects the GPA calculation that determines if an applicant meets or exceeds the minimum GPA UC requires based on residency status (2.0 GPA for CSU and 3.0 GPA for UC).
