

A-G REQUIREMENTS

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS & UC/CSU COURSE REQUIREMENTS



A: History/Social Sciences - 2 yrs. required: World History, US History

B: English - 4 yrs. required



C: Mathematics - 3 yrs. required including a full year of Geometry, 4 yrs. recommended

D: Laboratory Science - 2 yrs. required, 3 yrs. recommended E: Language other than English - 2 yrs. required, 3 yrs. recommended

F: Visual and Performing Arts - 1 yr. required

G: College Preparatory Elective - 1 yr. required



HONORS

FINDING A BALANCE

UC/CSU limits extra points added to designated honors courses in 10th grade to 4 semesters.

Algebra 2 and Spanish 2 are not UC/CSU honors designated.

The maximum number of designated courses receiving the additional grade points is 8 semesters on the UC/CSU application.

TESTING

UC

Fall 2021: elimination of the writing test

Fall 2021 & Fall 2022: test-optional

Fall 2023 & Fall 2024: Test blind

By 2025: elimination of the Act/Sat testing requirement. A new UC-endorsed test may be required.

CSU

Fall 2021, Winter 2022 & Spring 2022

Temporarily suspend the use of test the test score for eligibility





TYPES OF COLLEGE APPLICATION DEADLINES

Regular Decision

- Application submitted in November (public) & January and February (private)
- Admission decision sent in April
- Decision is not binding
- Can apply to multiple universities

Early Decision

- Application submitted in November
- Admission decision sent in December
- Decision is *binding*
- Can only apply to one university ED

Early Action

- Application submitted in November
- Admission decision sent in December
- Decision is non-binding
- Can apply to multiple universities EA

Rolling Admissions

- Colleges accept applications until spots are full
- Admission decisions are sent within the month of applying
- Decision is non-binding
- Can apply to multiple universities



SUMMARY OF ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

University of CA

- Completion of A-G courses
- 3.0 GPA minimum
- Test blind until 2022
- Personal Insight Questions
 No personal statement
- No letters of recommedation

CA State University

- Completion of A-G courses
- 2.5 GPA minimum
- Test requirement suspended
- - No letters of recommedation

Private University

- Typically, completion of A-G courses
- GPA minimum varies
- Test requirement varies
- Personal statement requirement varies
- Letters of recommedation

CA Community Colleges

- Admission is offered to students who obtain their HS Diploma or are 18 years of age
- No GPA or test score requirement
- No personal statement or letters of recommendation required

Applying for college strategically

- 2 Reach Schools

- 2 Safety Schools

Eligibility: meeting the minimum GPA baseline Competitive: far exceeding the minimum GPA baseline
