- Attend college fairs

#### Summer:

- •Continue revising Personal Insight Questions / Common App essays
- Review admission requirements
- •Create resume
- •Participate in summer activities/community service
- Campus Tours



# Impacts of COVID 19 on College Admissions: Eligibility

#### University of CA

In addition to GPA minimum (3.0), admission review includes other factors to determine eligibility and competitiveness since the SAT/ACT is not required for 2021-2022 college admission.

#### Cal State University

In addition to meeting GPA minimum (2.0-2.49), number of courses exceeding the A-G course sequence and extra curricular activities.

#### Private universities

Eligibility requirements may vary



# Impact of COVID 19 on College Admission: Testing

 University of CA: Test Blind, no Subject Test, no writing requirement

 California State University: Testing requirement suspended for 2021-2022

CHANGES AHEAD

 Private university test requirements may vary

#### Fall

- Begin the college application process in College, Career and Life (CCL)
- Finalize college list
- UC Schools-<u>Personal</u> Insight Questions
- Private Institutions-Letters of Recommendation
- College applications
- Schedule individual college planning meeting with your counselor
- Attend college rep. information sessions
- Attend college fairs
- Submit applications for colleges and for financial aid (<u>FAFSA</u> and/or <u>CSS Profile</u>).

# California State University (CSU)



23 campuses throughout California

Public 4-year universities

Application window October 1st - November 30th

#### Admission Requirements:

- A-G Course Completion
  - Courses taken with CR grading option in Spring 2020 will fulfill A-G requirements
- Minimum 2.5 GPA
  - Some schools will consider 2.0-2.49 gpa with additional factors

#### GPA calculator

 Standardized tests will not be utilized in making admission decisions for applicants during the 2022-2023 academic year.

9 campuses throughout California
Public 4-year universities
Application window October 1<sup>st</sup> - November 30<sup>th</sup>

#### Admission Requirements:

- A-G Course Completion
   CR grades in Spring 2020 will fulfill A-G requirements
- Minimum 3.0 GPAHow to calculate your gpa
- OACT/SAT test optional for Fall 2022 applicants
- oPersonal Insight Questions

### Private Schools - Local

# Over 100 campuses throughout California Admission requirements

- Application deadlines vary per campus
  - Early Action/Early Decision
- Cost of Attendance vary per campus
- Admission Requirements vary per campus
- Application with supplemental essays or question:
- SAT or ACT (possible)
- Letters of Recommendation (possible)



### Public Out of State

- Each state has its own university and state university system
- Requirements vary but are typically similar to our UC/CSU requirements
- Application deadlines vary per campus
  - Early Action/Early Decision
- Cost of Attendance vary per campus
- Total Enrollment vary per campus
- Tuition reduction available for eligible students at participating <u>WUE</u> schools

## California Community Colleges

- 114 campuses throughout California
- Public 2-year colleges
- Application window: Winter and Spring Rolling admission
- \$46 per unit or Promise Programs
- Total Enrollment varies per campus
- Admission Requirements:
  - Open Enrollment
  - Submit Application

Applying for college strategically

- 2 Reach Schools
- 4 Target Schools
- 2 Safety Schools

Eligibility: meeting the minimum GPA and test score baseline

Competitive: far exceeding the minimum GPA and test score baseline

#### **Application Fees\***

CSU- \$70.00 UC- \$70.00 Private - \$55.00-\$90.00 CCC - FREE

#### CSS Profile Fees

\$25.00 for first submission \$16.00 for each additional submission Require CSS Profile

#### Fee Waivers

CSU & UC-Embedded in the application process. If you qualify, you can receive up to 4 fee waivers for CSU's and 4 fee waivers for UC's. Private-Embedded in the application.
