
MARCH 8: INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

In 1908, 15,000 women marched in New York City demanding voting rights, better pay and shorter hours. A year after that, the first National Woman's Day was established in the US in 1909. It was decided in 1911 that International Women's Day would be held annually on March 8.
