☐ Fridays will now be on a block schedule, so the weekly schedules will be on a 2-week cycle. Seminars will remain on Mondays/Wednesday and Tuesdays/Thursdays. ☐ Master Schedule includes 5 “Academic Advisory” sections to support students who struggle academically.. ☐ 9th grade students will take Algebra 1 <u>and</u> Geometry, or Geometry <u>and</u> Statistics ☐ A new Statistics course will be taught by Jeannine ☐ A new section of Geometry for 11th & 12th grade students will be taught by Ms. Kondo. ☐ A new section of Civil Engineering Honors has been added for 12th graders. ☐ US History honors will not be a separate section. ☐ One section of College Writing will be offered during P7 seminar. ☐ POE and CIM will now have honors options. ☐ Art 1 will be offered as a double seminar (open to students of all grade levels). ☐ There will be a section of combined POE/CIM/ERD for FRC students taught by Mr. Tostado. ☐ Advisory will use a common slide deck & schedule, featuring “Business Mondays” with school announcements, and “Listening Tuesdays” with council prompts for the curriculum. ☐ New seminars (tentative): Arduino programming, Calligraphy, US History & Current Events, Theater ☐ Retired seminars: DVSuccess, Space Exploration, Cycling, Anime Art, Improv, Fabrication Lab	☐ Counselors will provide holistic socioemotional, academic, and college counseling to students. Parents may request to change these time slots via email. ☐ Narrative comments on student report cards at the end of each semester will be replaced by a listing of the student’s grade in each EKS assessed, along with its description and weighting. ☐ Students are allowed to wear headphones in or over their ears, or around their necks. ☐ Students are also not allowed to use amplified sound devices (ie bluetooth speakers) at school.
